

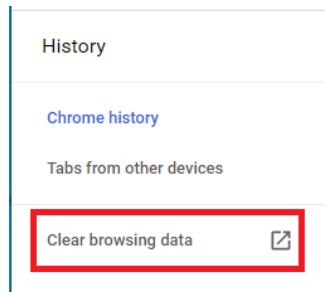
Clearing Your Browser Cache

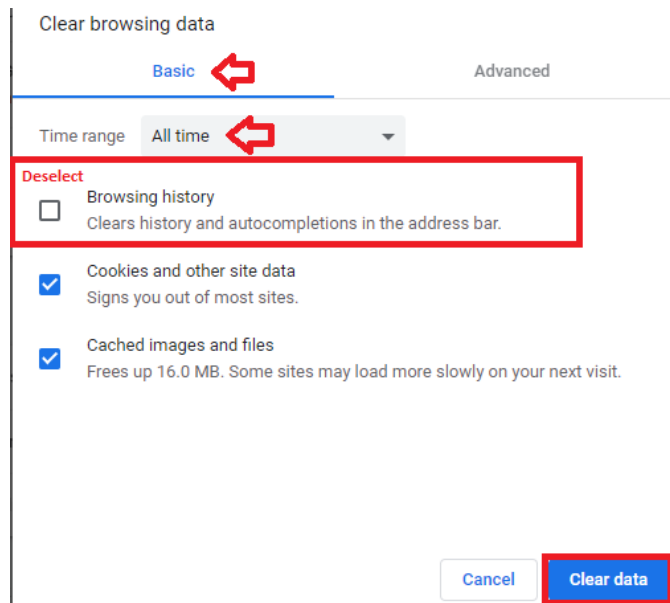

Chrome

1. While holding down the Control (Ctrl) key, hit the H key→select **Clear Browsing Data** from the left-hand side.



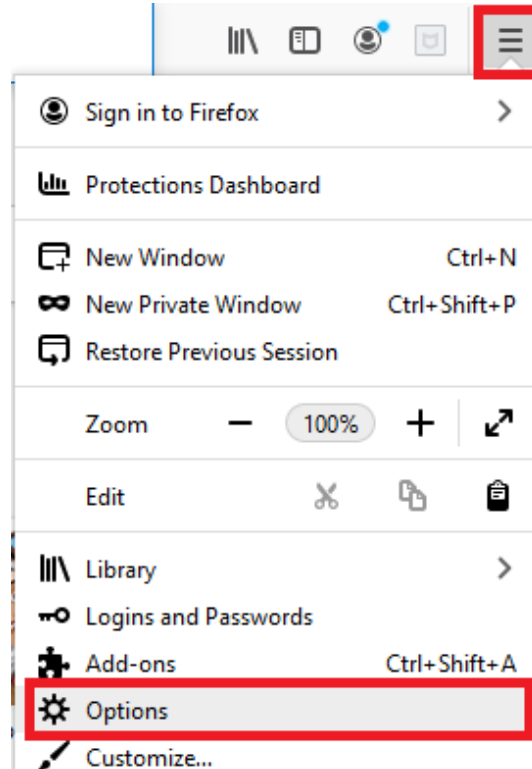
2. On the Basic tab, check to make sure you are on the default **Time Range** setting “**All Time**,” then click the checkbox to deselect **Browsing History**. (If you leave this selected, you will no longer have convenient URL address autocomplete for websites you’ve visited.) Leave the default checkmarks for **Cookies and other site data** and **Cached images and files** and click **Clear Data**.



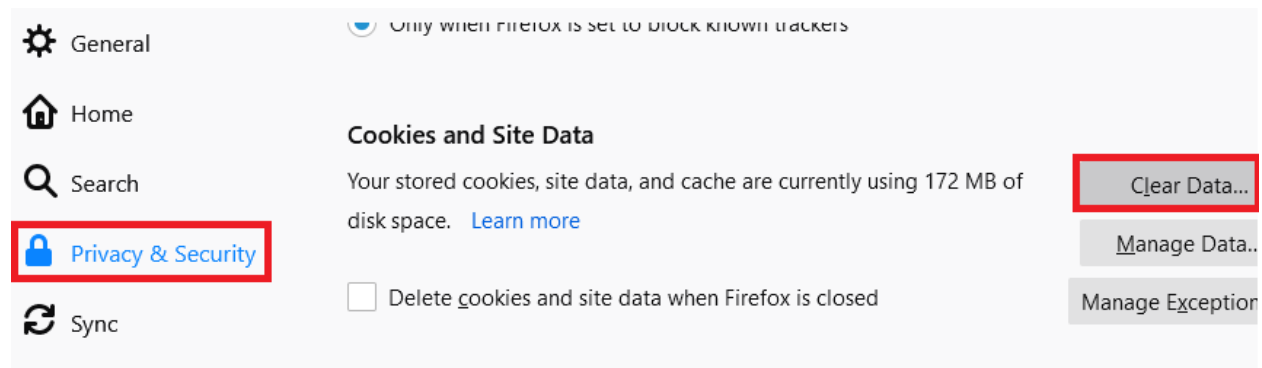
3. Windows users will need to close and re-open Chrome to save these changes. On an Apple computer, go to the **Chrome** menu on the top menu bar and select **Quit** for the changes to take effect.

Firefox

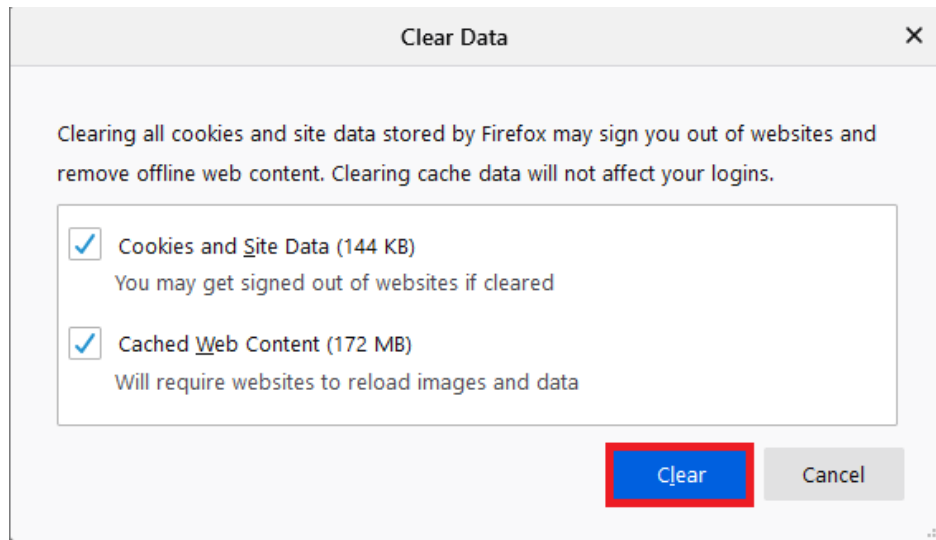
1. Click the Menu hamburger icon in the upper right corner of your browser and select Options.



2. In the left menu, click **Privacy & Security**→scroll down to the Cookies and Site Data section and click the **Clear Data** button→in the Clear Data popup window, make sure checkboxes are checked for Cookies and Site Data and Cached Web Content.



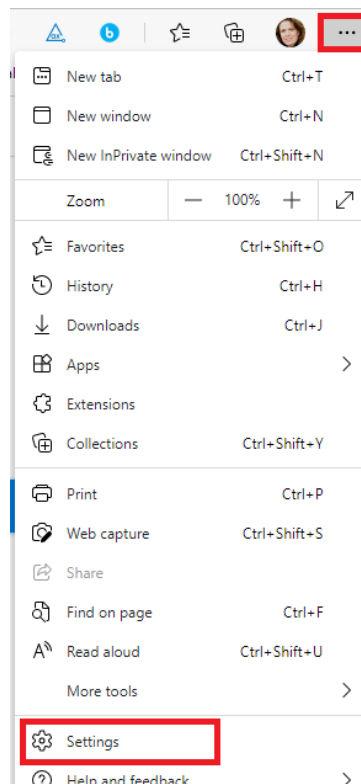
3. Click the **Clear** button.



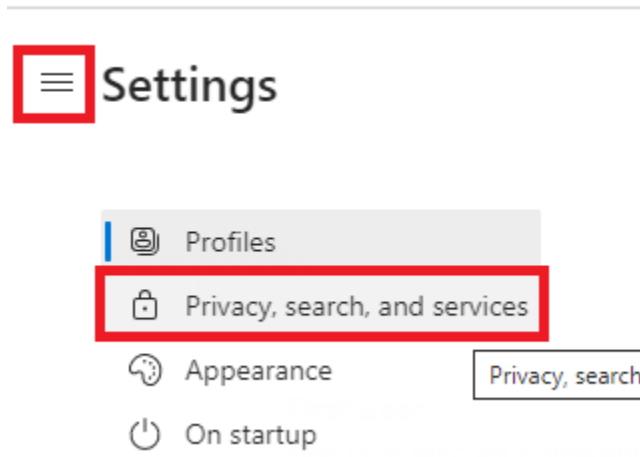
4. Windows users will need to close and re-open Firefox to save the changes. Apple users will need to click the **Firefox Menu** hamburger icon (upper right), then select **Quit** for changes to take effect.

Microsoft Edge

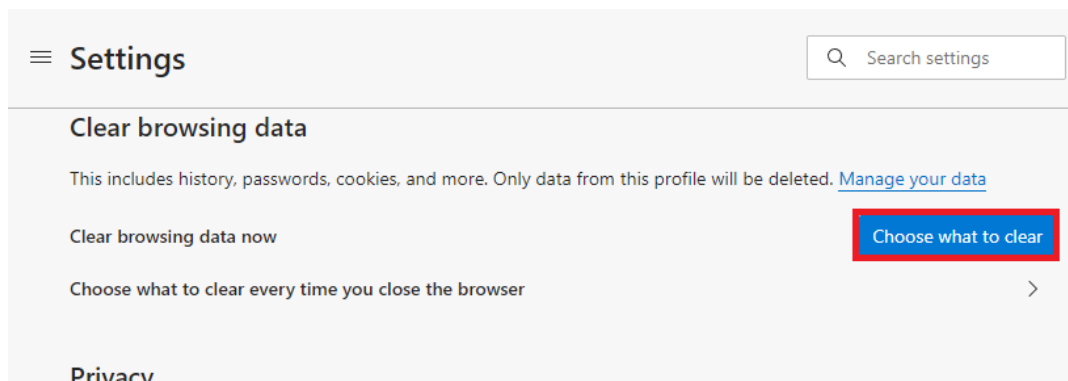
1. Click the Edge Menu dropdown icon in the upper right corner of your browser and select Settings.



2. Click the Settings dropdown menu hamburger icon and click Privacy, search and services.



3. Scroll down to the “Clear browsing data” section and click the blue **Choose what to clear** button.



4. Click the **Time range** dropdown menu and select **All time**→deselect Browsing history→click the blue **Clear Now** button→close Edge for changes to take effect.
